Motivation and Meaning-Making in School

How can motivation be understood as a unique driving force for the well-being of children and adolescents in school if they experience that it makes sense for them? Motivation is about feeling autonomy, experiencing competence, and feeling like a part of a community in harmony with others. In this afterwork-meeting, we will discuss how we can work with and for this motivation.

Autism and anxiety in children and youth

How should we understand the anxiety that many children and young people with autism experience? Anxiety is often observed when the child or young person has been in a state for an extended period that has overloaded their nervous system. The anxiety can therefore be understood in connection with autism, and it is possible to work with and address anxiety by starting from the perspective of autism.

Selective mutism – when the voice "disappears"

How should the silence be understood, and what should one be aware of when children's voices disappear? We perceive children's silence as a symptom of discomfort, which may have its roots in various causes. We will discuss how you, as a professional or as a parent, can work with and support children and youth who are not speaking.

School Absenteeism

How should we understand the increasing trend observed with more and more children not attending school? The cause of this concerning school absenteeism is not always the same, and often there is a high level of complexity associated with it. The approach to helping the child return to school can also be seen as complex. In this meeting, we will discuss how to approach school absenteeism and collaborate across homes, schools, and municipalities.
